PERSISTENT IDENTIFIER - PID

- ▶ Definition :
 - ▶ A long-lasting,
 - ▶ globally unique,
 - ▶ and resolvable code
 - ▶ that identifies a digital object, person, organization, or other entity.

PERSISTENT IDENTIFIER - PID

- ▶ Key Characteristics of PID
 - ▶ Persistent
 - ▶ The identifier remains valid and resolvable over time, regardless of changes in the underlying resource's location or metadata
 - ▶ Globally Unique
 - ▶ Each PID identifies a single, specific entity, preventing ambiguity and ensuring accurate identification.
 - ▶ Machine-Readable/Resolvable:
 - ▶ processed by computers, allowing for automated retrieval of information and linking between different systems.

PERSISTENT IDENTIFIER - PID

- ▶ Examples of PIDs
 - ▶ DOI (Digital Object Identifier)
 - ▶ Commonly used for research publications, datasets, and other digital objects
 - ▶ ROR (Research Organization Registry) ID
 - ▶ Identifies research organizations.
 - ▶ Handle System:
 - ▶ A general-purpose identifier system that can be used for various types of resources.

PERSISTENT IDENTIFIER - PID

- ▶ Examples of PIDs
 - ▶ ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID)
 - ▶ Used to identify individual researchers and their contributions.
 - ▶ Scopus ID
 - ▶ Tracks an author's publications, citations, h-index, and research output in Scopus.
 - ▶ ISNI (International Standard Name Identifier)
 - ▶ The ISO certified global standard number for identifying the millions of contributors to creative works and those active in their distribution.
 - ▶ ResearcherID by Web of Science (Clarivate Analytics)
 - ▶ Links an author's Web of Science-indexed publications and tracks citation metrics.

ORCID (OPEN RESEARCHER AND CONTRIBUTOR ID)

- ▶ helps distinguish between researchers with similar names and ensures proper attribution of work.
- ▶ <https://orcid.org>
 - ▶ Example: A researcher named "A. Perera" may have an ORCID iD like: <https://orcid.org/0000-0002-1825-0097>

ORCID MEMBERSHIPS

▸ Two types

1) Individual Users

Freely can join without any affiliation to your organization.

2) Organizational Members

i) Direct membership – annually paid membership by the organizations

ii) Consortia Membership – annually paid (reduced amount than above) non profit organizations

- ▶ You can skip adding the Affiliation to the working institute of yours.
- ▶ You'll receive an email to verify the given email at the end of the registration

Step 4 of 5 - Visibility

Your ORCID iD connects with your ORCID record that can contain links to your research activities, affiliations, awards, other versions of your name, and more. You control this content and who can see it.

Visibility settings
